

Sub.: Posting of Senior Geologists / Geologists in Polar Studies Division, NCEGR, Faridabad

Polar Studies Division, NCEGR, Geological Survey of India, Faridabad has pre-eminence in the field of geological and climate change research in Antarctica and Arctic (Svalbard, Norway Region) for last three decades. In Antarctica, the research programs are being taken up every year by the Polar Studies Division with the broad objective to understand Ice Sheet dynamics of part of large East Antarctica Ice Sheet (EAIS) from Maitri base, Late Quaternary climate changes in Antarctica and reconstruction of Gondwana model. In the Svalbard regions of Arctic Norway, glaciological studies, monitoring of glaciers and studies related to Late Quaternary deglaciation history of the Ny Alesund are being carried out.

To maintain GSI's legacy in the field of glaciological and climate change studies, it is proposed to induct a dedicated team of young geo-scientists in Polar Studies Division with enthusiasm to pursue earth science in the arduous terrains of the earth. Therefore, applications are invited from Senior Geologists / Geologists of Geological Survey of India having sufficient scientific aptitude with relevant demonstrative experience for posting in Polar Studies Division, NCEGR, GSI, Faridabad. Willing officers may submit their applications along with complete biodata including their field / laboratory experience through HoDs of the respective Regions to reach this office on or before 31st July 2017.
